

2022 Blueberry Festival & Craft Fair

Vendor Information and Application

The Fellowship of the First Congregational Church of Kittery will hold their annual Blueberry Festival & Craft Fair on Saturday, August 13th, 2022 on the church grounds at 23 Pepperrell Road (Route 103) in Kittery Point, Maine.

The Summer Craft Fair is advertised from 9:00 – 3:00. The Pancake Breakfast begins at 7:30 am, so this may bring in some early shoppers. The event will be held RAIN or SHINE! The BLUEBERRY PANCAKE and SAUSAGE breakfast will be held from 7:30 a.m. until 9:30 a.m. Lunch will be served from 11:30 a.m. until 2 p.m.

Reservations for outdoor vendor space may be made by sending a check for \$50 per space, payable to *The Fellowship*, with the attached application. Reservations MUST be received by August 5th. (or by July 30th if you require a table) Spaces are approximately 10'x10'. While we work hard to honor vendor preferences around location, we will accommodate those with mobility or other health concerns as first priority, and cannot guarantee a particular location with one hundred percent certainty.

We have a limited number of six foot tables available for vendor use for an additional \$10 each. Please specify below, and add \$10 to your payment for a total of \$60 if you require a table.

Arrive early in time to set up and enjoy a pancake & sausage breakfast. We will provide delivery service to your table! Set up begins at 7 a.m. Please plan to arrive to set up NO LATER than 8 a.m. You will be asked to park at Mitchell Primary School, just around the corner, after unloading. NEW for 2022: we have hired a professional shuttle bus service which will run throughout the day. With over 30 vendors anticipated, this will allow ample parking for shoppers of the craft fair!

There will be a baked goods table full of yummy treats and lots of blueberry goodies including Homemade Blueberry Pies, and The Blueberry Café will offer a variety of delicious lunch options for purchase. There will also be live music at the event.

This is strictly a *handmade* craft fair. No flea market items or MLM vendors will be accepted. This is an entirely outdoor event (access to restrooms inside the Parish House - masks provided at entrance) to be held rain or shine. Once your application and payment have been received, you've received a confirmation email, your spot has been reserved and **no refunds** will be issued. We reserve the right to decline any vendor application if necessary, however we hope to see many familiar faces returning!
